Job Description, **Assistant Curator**

The National Museum of Military Vehicles is seeking to fill its **Assistant Curator** position. This is a full-time salaried position with benefits.

Candidates should demonstrate a minimum of three (3) years of prior history museum experience, with additional experience preferred. A bachelor's degree in American History, or Museum Studies, is required. A master's degree is preferred. Other majors with relevant coursework may be considered.

Duties of this position are to assist the Curatorial Department in:

1. Conducting scheduled interpretive tours for museum visitors. Tours are an important aspect of the museum's presentation to the visitor. You should be comfortable speaking with diverse audiences on multiple topics of U.S. history and military history.
2. Collections maintenance. You should have experience in handling artifacts and an understanding of proper museum collections storage. This should include a background researching, identification of, and cataloguing artifacts.
3. Exhibit maintenance. Assisting in exhibit updates and maintenance. You should be able to understand and follow detailed directions and feel comfortable asking for clarification.
4. Support curatorial department with focused research, as assigned. You should have a professional understanding of research and writing.
5. Other duties as assigned by curator
