GUEST POLICIES

- 1. Guests may not bring large bags, luggage, musical instruments, or backpacks into the building. Guests may be asked to leave any large personal items such as backpacks in their vehicles.
- 2. NMMV reserves the right to refuse service to anyone.
- 3. Shirt and shoes are required for all visitors.
- 4. For the safety of guests, volunteers, and staff, NMMV will not tolerate unacceptable behavior. Unacceptable behavior includes but is not limited to:
 - Verbally abusive, harassing, discriminatory, or threatening statements or behavior toward NMMV staff, volunteers, or other visitors
 - Soliciting
 - Posting or distributing any sign, petition, notice, ad, pamphlet, or other print materials without NMMV staff permission
 - Sexual harassment
 - Overt signs of substance abuse, including drunkenness
 - Sleeping in the building
 - Using bikes, skateboards, or skates in any part of the building, outside the building's main entrance, or at the front monument area
 - Obstructing foot traffic
 - Entering any non-public area without authorization
- 5. To avoid accidents, be aware of your surroundings and keep a safe distance from exhibit cases, platforms, and vehicles.
- 6. Please dispose of any food, drink, or gum prior to entering the galleries. Non-glass water bottles may be brought into the galleries.
- 7. Animals are not permitted anywhere in the building, with the exception of service animals.
- 8. Smoking and e-cigarettes are not permitted anywhere in the building.
- 9. Please do not touch, lean, climb, sit, or place items on any of the cases, vehicles, or artifacts unless prompted to do so by signage or guidance.
- 10. Be mindful of others while using a cellphone.
- 11. Motorized scooters and rollators are available for guest convenience. Guests assume all liability while using a scooter or rollator.
- 12. Guests may use strollers or store them at the coat check area in the lobby.
- 13. Children must be accompanied by an adult at all times.
- 14. Visitors may use NMMV telephones for emergencies only.
- 15. NMMV is not responsible for lost or stolen property.
- 16. NMMV operates closed circuit video monitoring for the safety of the artifacts, public, and staff.

Photography and video is permitted in the museum under the following circumstances:
