High-Altitude Army National Guard Aviation Training Site to Visit Museum

Dubois, WY (August 27, 2023) – The High-Altitude Army National Guard Aviation Training Site (HAATS) will be bringing two Sikorsky UH-60 Black Hawks and one CH-47 Chinook helicopter to the Museum on September 6th. The helicopters will land at 10:30 AM and the public is welcome to watch.

HAATS is a unique training facility based in Colorado. It uses a specialized methodology to improve situational awareness in high-altitude, mountainous terrain. The training is conducted in the Rocky Mountains, which provides a realistic and challenging environment for pilots to learn.

This is a rare opportunity to see these amazing helicopters up close. The UH-60 Black Hawk is a medium-lift helicopter that is used for a variety of missions, including troop transport, medical evacuation, and search and rescue. The CH-47 Chinook is a heavy-lift helicopter that is used for transporting troops and supplies.

The helicopters will be on display for a short time after landing. Visitors will have the opportunity to speak with the crew and learn more about the training that is conducted at HAATS.
