Learning Objectives:

- Identify how ration booklets changed the production rate and consumption

The lesson will begin with students discussing what events in their lives have shaped who they are today. This will promote the association with the topic we will be discussing for the length of

the tour. We will begin in the galleries when the group has covered events and how they change outcomes. We will discuss how the U.S. industrialized in the early stages of WWII, we will also have a discussion about minorities and Rosie the Riveter. As we progress through the Marshall gallery we will discuss the lend lease program and how it impacted the United States economy specifically production, distribution, and consumption. Finally, as we progress into Korea and Vietnam we will discuss how the United Nations was created and how its creation changed production, consumption, and distribution during the Korean War and the Vietnam War. In each of the galleries, we will discuss how production, distribution, and consumption changed and what technology changed it for the better or impacted it in a negative way.
